Customs Workers' Union (SUPARA) Strike Suspended

Buenos Aires, April 28th, 2025

Please be informed that the Customs Workers Union (SUPARA) has decided to suspend the strike and system blackout measures previously scheduled for April 29th and 30th, following the progress achieved with the Authorities regarding salary adjustments.

SUPARA has stated that, although the progress achieved is considered insufficient, the union will continue engaging in dialogue with the authorities, defending the validity of the collective bargaining agreement and the right to free wage negotiations.

Be informed that the Customs Workers Union (SUPARA) has called for a new national Strike and computer blackout of the "System" with personnel present in their working places, being the measure scheduled for April 15th, 16th, 29th and 30th from 07:00 hs to 19:00 hs.

At this stage it is uncertain how the measures / strike will impact vessel operations across all ports, however, it is likely that some vessels in specific ports will experience disruptions, depending on how local union representatives support the measure.
